

Subject: Water removal

Case study

A 54-year-old man, recently recovering from a plumbing leak in his basement, experienced persistent fatigue, mild headaches, and sinus congestion. He initially sought conventional treatment, which ruled out acute infection but suggested that lingering mold from previous water damage might be contributing to his symptoms. Discomfort continued despite medication, prompting him to try bioresonance therapy as a complement to his care.

Bioresonance testing indicated an energetic imbalance related to environmental stressors, particularly in the respiratory and immune systems. Therapy focused on harmonizing cell frequencies and supporting energy balance throughout the body—especially targeting areas identified as burdened by damp conditions. After several sessions, the client reported improved vitality and a reduction in sinus symptoms. While not a substitute for medical treatment or mold remediation, bioresonance was experienced as an adjunctive support for his overall sense of well-being, helping him "restore overall energy balance with bioresonance therapy" and "complement bioresonance with traditional medication to maximize health outcomes."
