

Subject: Endometriosis

Case study

A 34-year-old woman with a ten-year history of endometriosis presented with chronic pelvic pain, fatigue, and discomfort during menstruation. After multiple laparoscopic surgeries, hormone treatments, and pain management plans, her symptoms persisted, affecting her quality of life. Seeking further relief, she explored integrative care and opted for bioresonance therapy alongside ongoing medical supervision.

Bioresonance assessment indicated energetic imbalances, particularly around pelvic organs and the immune system. Sessions focused on harmonizing cell frequencies and restoring energy flow to areas identified as energetically depleted.
